A letter of authorisation exists to authorise members of staff not currently holding a personal licence, to sell alcohol.

Measures taken to comply with underage sales are as follows:

Age verification policy in place-

Challenge 25 poster is displayed. Electronic documentation of all refused sales, prompted by the till. Staff are aware of the requirements for verification- driving licence, valid passport, European ID card.

The CCTV has 30 days in excess of the required 28 days. Refusal log is completed as per till prompts. Training records are kept.
Staff training for personal licences has been arranged for the coming week for 2 persons.

The shops closes at 19:30 daily.
