The Mayor has ruled, in accordance with Section 100B(4)(b) of the Local Government Act 1972, that the following motion submitted by Councillor Crooks should be considered as a matter of urgency in light of the developing situation following the death of George Floyd in the United States of America and the Black Lives Matter Campaign.

“Black Lives Matter

That this Council:

- (a) mindful of the death of George Floyd in the United States and of the demonstrations that followed;
- (b) aware of the depth of public concern expressed during the last week in Britain about ingrained institutional racism directed against non-whites, particularly following events in Bristol on 7 June 2020;
- (c) conscious of the difficulty of organising supportive community demonstrations at the present time while maintaining social distancing requirements;
- (d) therefore, on behalf of all Milton Keynes residents; and
- (e) urgently places on record its support for the objectives of the Black Lives Matter movement and for all similar initiatives.”
