### 1. **Welcome and Introductions**

### 5. **Commissioning 2023 Update**

The purpose of the Commissioning and Procurement Programme 2023 is to review public realm services and align contracts. There will be multiple service changes proposed for April 2023, including the biggest change to key front line services (waste collection) in twenty years. The Committee will receive a presentation from the Head of Environment & Waste (Item 5) (**Pages 9 to 88**) setting out the options and next steps for the assets and services that make up this programme of work.

This is an opportunity for the Committee to scrutinise, comment on or make further recommendations on these proposals before any formal approval is given to proceed to a preferred delivery model.

## **6. Waste and Recycling Collection Consultation**

Milton Keynes aspires to be one of the greenest cities in the world. As part of achieving this aim, recycling levels need to increase and the quality of recycling collected needs to improve. A review of how waste is collected is an important part of this process.

The Cabinet member for Public Realm and Housing will be considering approving a waste and recycling collection consultation with residents at Delegated Decisions on the 13 October 2020. If approved the consultation period will run from November 2020 to January 2021.

The Committee is invited to review the consultation document and submit its observations as part of the consultation.

A copy of the report being considered by the Cabinet member is attached at Item 6a (**Pages 89 to 101**) and a copy of the presentation from the Head of Environment and Waste is included in the Agenda Pack as Item 6b (**Pages 102 to 107**).

## **7. The 'New Normal'**

An item on the 'New Normal' is scheduled to be considered by this Committee at its next meeting on the 13 January 2021. The purpose is to scrutinise how things that are covered by the remit of this Committee have changed for Milton Keynes since the Covid-19 pandemic and how those changes will affect growth plans going forward.

The Committee will receive an introduction to this item from Cllr Geary who will set out what this item will cover and the input required from Committee members prior to the next meeting.
