Our Town Planning & Management Committee met last night to discuss the above licence application and the following was minuted:

218.1 The Pattern Maker, 28 St John Street – The Committee objected to this application on the following grounds:

- **Crime and Disorder** – The availability of alcohol at the times stated is likely to have an adverse impact on incidents of crime and disorder. Any further cuts to police numbers may exacerbate this.
- **Public Safety** – Any increase in crime and disorder will undoubtedly have an adverse impact on public safety.
- **Public Nuisance** – There will almost certainly be increased public nuisance caused by the proposed use of the premises which are very close to a residential area including adjoining private property.
- **Protection of Children from Harm** – There is likely to be an increased risk of harm to children due to the nature of the business on the grounds listed above. Moreover, the premises are on a route to a local school.
