I would like to make a representation to this application on behalf of Environmental Health regarding noise disturbance.

The area around the premises is mainly residential and all other non-residential premises in the area face on to the High Street. The premises lack of a private outside area means that those customers wishing to smoke would have to do so at the front of the premises on Downham Road and the size of the premises is likely to lead to windows being open during warm evenings, both of these factors along customers leaving up to 22:00 have the potential to cause public nuisance to neighbouring residents.

The applicant could consider reducing the hours to 20:00, if this is done I would consider withdrawing my representation.
