Details of Other Plugged in Places (PIP) Areas and Their Proposals for Continuation of the Scheme beyond the End of the PIP Project

- Source London – administered by Transport for London (TfL) one of the original 3 PiPs. TfL are believed to be preparing to tender for a partner.
- Source East – administered by a commercial entity EValu8, one of the Phase 2 PiPs. EValu8 are believed to want to continue as a commercial charging scheme.
- Plugged-in Midlands – administered by a commercial entity CENEX, one of the Phase 2 PiPs. CENEX are believed to be trying to continue for a further year, before looking to divest themselves of the scheme.
- Charge Your Car (NE England) – administered by Charge Your Car Ltd, one of the original 3 PiPs. CYC are believed to be trying to continue as a commercial enterprise with ambitions to develop into a national provider.
- Plugged-in Places Scotland – administered by the Scottish Government, one of the Phase 2 PiPs. There is no intelligence over the future plans for this PiP, though it is likely to continue under the guidance of the Scottish Government.
- Plugged-in Places Northern Ireland – administered by eCAR who are part of the Northern Ireland Government. eCAR are one of the Phase 2 PiPs and have very close ties to the charging posts scheme operated in Ireland by the local electricity supplier. There is no intelligence over the future plans for this PiP.
