## MEMO

OCCASIONS & HAVE PHONED THE PUB TO ASK THEM TO TURN DOWN WHAT HAS BEEN TOLD TO US WAS "A JUKEROX". IN SUMMER, THE PROBLEM IS MUCH WORSE AS WINDOWS ARE LEFT OPEN & THE LICENSEES HAVE, WE ASSUME, THEIR OWN AFTER-HOURS PARTIES.

THE LICENSEES ARE NOT CONSCIENTIOUS IN KEEPING NOISE TO A MINIMUM AND WE HAVE HAD TO PHONE THEM, ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH OFFICERS AND THE POLICE ON NUMEROUS OCCASIONS. IN AN E-MAIL FROM THE LICENSEE TO THE COUNCIL (WHICH WAS WRONGLY COPIED TO US), THE LICENSEE SUGGESTED IT WAS OUR OWN FAULT THAT WE WERE DISTURBED BY <sup>MUSIC</sup> NOISE BECAUSE "THEY WERE SAT IN THEIR GARDEN"

WE ARE VERY LIKELY TO BE DISTURBED, KEPT AWAKE OR WOKEN UP BY MUSIC PLAYED AFTER 11PM & BY PEOPLE LEAVING A MUCH NOISIER ENVIRONMENT THAN BEFORE.

WE DO NOT HAVE DOUBLE-GLAZING & WE CAN HEAR EVEN RELATIVELY QUIET CONVERSATIONS OF PEOPLE LEAVING THE CRAWFORD IN THE SMALL HOURS.
