CRIME AND COMMUNITY SAFETY

Report of Isabella Fraser (Campbell Park Parish Council)

The Consultative Assembly will be aware that I have been appointed as the Local Council's representative on the Crime and Community Safety Partnership.

It was reported at the last meeting of the Assembly that I had attended the first meeting of the Partnership and was digesting all of the information I had received. The Assembly asked that a report be made to its next meeting.

I have received further information on the Crime and Safety Partnership which I have passed to the Secretaries of the MK Association of Local Councils and MK Association of Urban Parish Councils for forwarding to all Local Councils.

The only feedback I have received from Local Councils to date has been from the rural areas in respect of policing levels and from the urban areas concerns about travellers and anti-social behaviour were expressed.

A proposal has been put forward that a sub group of the Crime and Safety Partnership should be established for Local Councils. I am in contact with the two Associations regarding how this matter could be taken forward.
