Licensable activities are also permitted in the event of the live televised transmission of any important National or International sporting event outside of standard hours. The details of the activity will be notified to the police and Licensing Authority a minimum of 14 days before the event with absolute Police veto.

The opening hours of the premises

New Years Eve from 11:00 until standard opening hours the next day

Closing time may be extended by 1 hour on the following days:

Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

No supply of alcohol may be made where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the licence, or when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or it is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

Licensable activities are restricted to the internal ground floor areas shown on the attached plan

ALCOHOL

In respect of the hours given for alcohol sales the above restrictions do not prohibit:

- a. during the first twenty minutes after the licensed hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- b. consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- c. the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- d. the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- e. the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;
- f. the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- g. the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.

Off Sales of alcohol for consumption beyond the premise boundary must be sold in a sealed container and must not be consumed within the premise boundary

GENERAL

The maximum seating capacity of the premise (including all persons) is:
70 in the restaurant and 60 to the bar

Relevant staff including house managers will receive training on how to deal with illegal activities; aggressive customers; sales refusal; underage sales and implementation of the company sensible drinking policy

The Premises Licence Holder or his nominated representative will maintain membership of any existing Barwatch Scheme of which the premises licensed is a current member, or join any future scheme, which is not currently in existence. He/she will ensure co-operation with the relevant scheme, abide by any rules and ensure meetings are regularly attended.

The Premise Licence holder shall ensure that there is sufficient illumination of the car parks and walkways to allow for safe ingress and egress from the premises

An APS (Advance Protection System) will be installed and maintained operational during any period of Licensable Activity

Except for ingress, egress or emergency all external doors and windows shall be maintained closed during 'live' entertainment performances. *INFORMATIVE: This is taken to include Karaoke and Dancing as well as Live Music*

Signage requesting customers to leave quietly will be prominently displayed at public exits upon the premise.

Use of the outside drinking areas shall cease no later than 23:00 except for access to or egress from the premise

External background music shall cease no later than 21:00 on any night

No persons under the age of 16 to be permitted on the premises site after 21:00

Signage will be prominently displayed on any amusement machines detailing relevant age restrictions.

An audited proof of age scheme will be in place in respect of underage sales

Other than for access and egress the presence of persons under the age of 16 is restricted to dining areas as indicated on the plan.

INFORMATIVE: Late Night Refreshment includes takeaway sales
