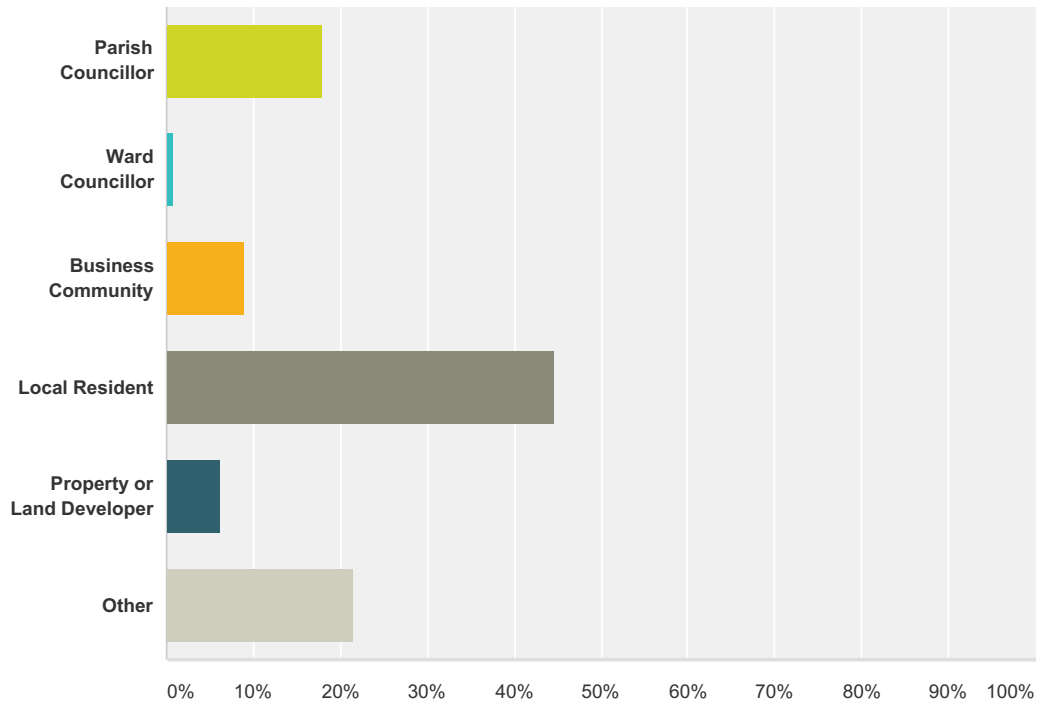


Q1 Which group do you belong to?

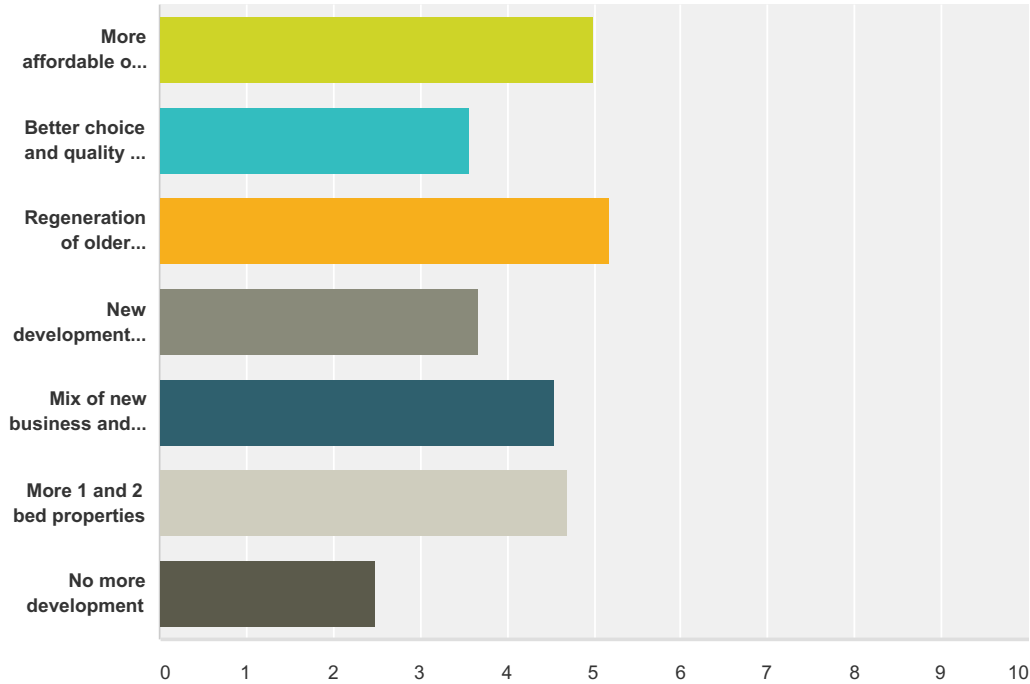

Q2 What type of development is most important to you? [please rank, 1 most important - 7 least important]

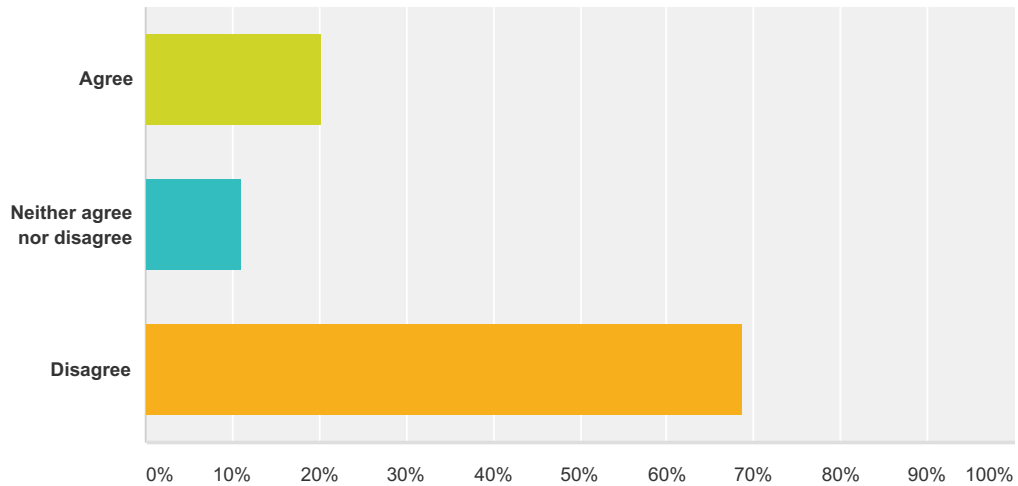

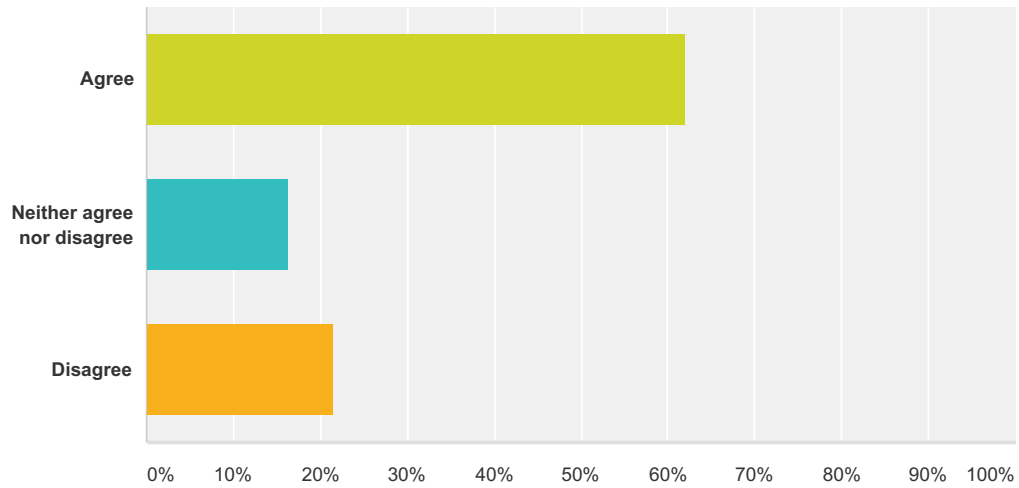

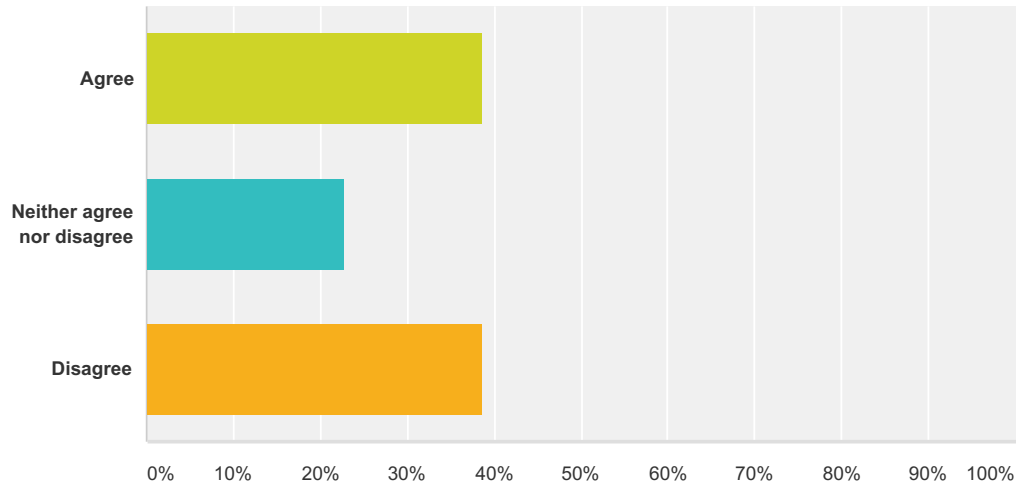

Q5 Do you agree with the following statement: Speakers for and against a proposal should not make duplicate statements during a debate so the time is used more effectively

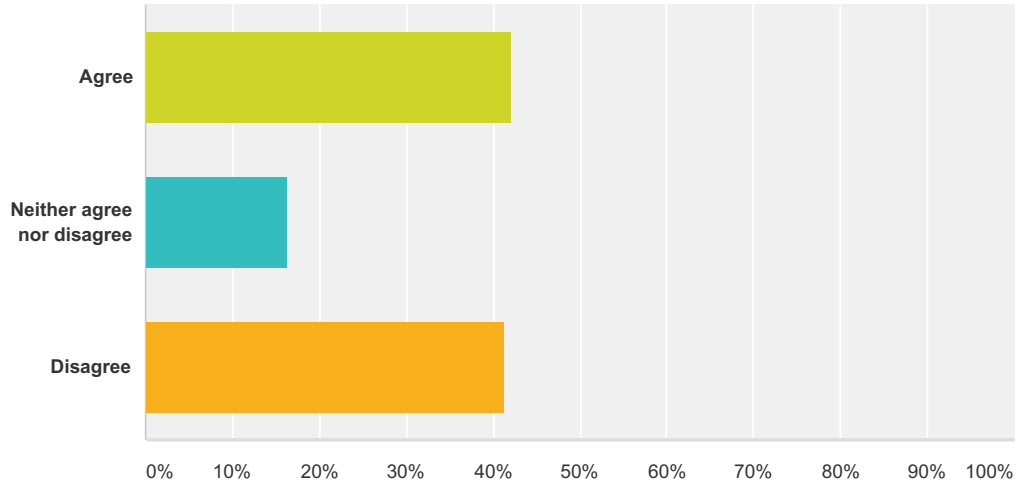

Q6 Do you agree with the following statement: The Chair should exercise their powers to stop speakers repeating and duplicating comments

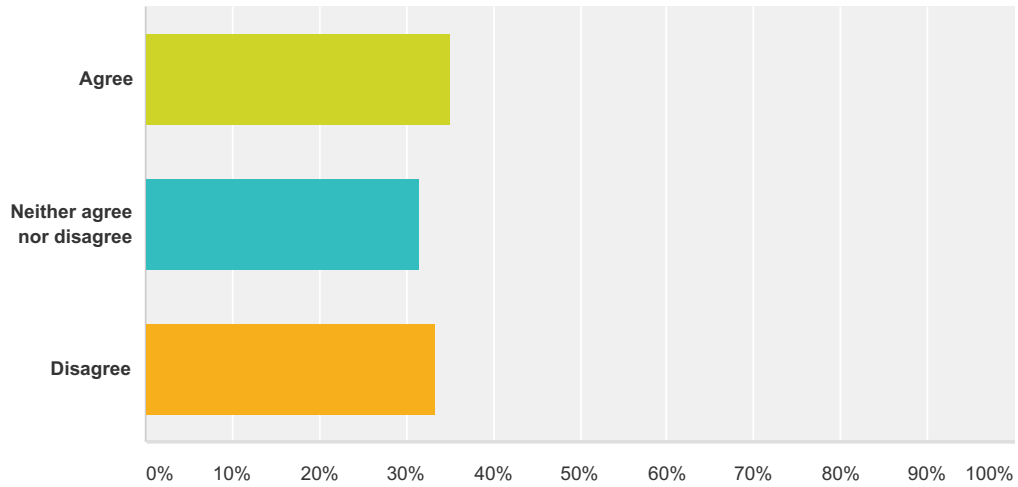

Q7 Do you agree with the following statement: The Council should look to reduce costs in the determination of planning applications

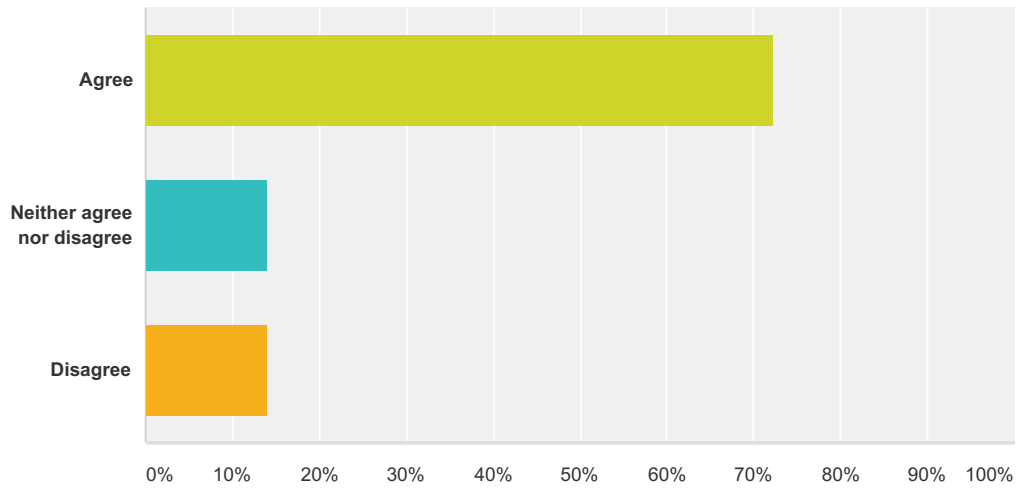

Q8 Do you agree with the following statement: Those making representations should be given equal time and rights

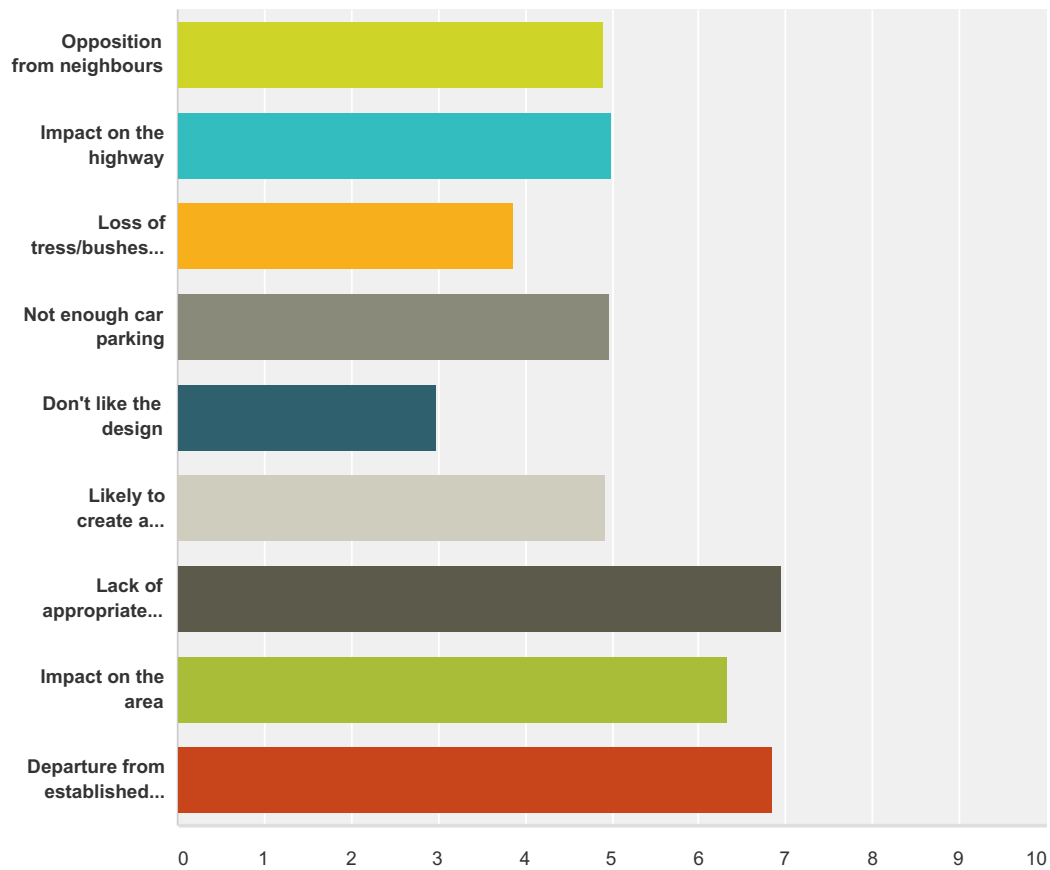
