

## MKIPA SURVEY OF SCHOOLS UPDATE

### Background

In August 1998, the Milton Keynes International Partnerships Association (MKIPA) were commissioned by Milton Keynes Council to look into the links that Milton Keynes schools, youth groups and other organisations may have. The results for schools have recently been updated in a follow up survey by MK Council (June 1999).

### Results

Attached are updated lists of combined, middle, and secondary schools in MK, and the nature of international links that they may have (if any).

#### The figures break down thus:

- **53%** of schools catering for children over 8 years old list have formal links with schools or organisations abroad
- **76.5%** of schools listed participate in international activity of some form (regardless of links)
- only **23.5%** of schools have no international activity at all

(note: Leon School and St Thomas Aquinas not included in calculations, as we still await a response).

### Conclusions

These figures indicate that the vast majority do have some international activity, and that schools without formal links can still have international activity.
