1. Findings of Fact

The Sub-Committee accepted the following findings of fact from the evidence available:

- The hearing is to determine a renewal application for a ten hour street trading consent between the hours of 1pm to 11pm every day.
- MK Dosa corner have operated from the same location within 60 metres of Fishermead Boulevard for almost 5 years.
- Consent in respect of this site was first given in September 2009 as Fishermead Boulevard is designated a "consent street" under the adopted provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions)Act 1982.
- The Licensing Authority has received no complaints regarding the MK Dosa Corner and recent visits have only picked up issues on parking.
