### **Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions**

No supply of alcohol may be made where there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the licence, or when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or it is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

### **Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

Licensable activities are restricted to the internal area marked on the attached plan

The Premises Licence Holder will maintain membership of any existing Barwatch Scheme of which the premises licensed is a current member, or join any future scheme which is not currently in existence. He/she will ensure co-operation with the relevant scheme, abide by any rules and ensure meetings are regularly attended.

The outside of the premise will remain well lit during licensable activities

Staff will regularly check toilet areas

An adequate system of emergency lighting and an appropriate number of fire extinguishers will be maintained operational at the premise

An incident and accident book will be maintained on the premise

An adequate pest control contract will be retained and implemented at the premise

Unaccompanied children are not permitted at the premise

Non alcoholic beverages will always be available

Any cigarette machines or AWP machines will be sited so they can be easily seen from the bar servery

Staff will have a system in place to arrange taxis for customers

### **ALCOHOL**

In respect of the hours given for alcohol sales the above restrictions do not prohibit:

- a. during the first twenty minutes after the licensed hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
- b. consumption of the alcohol on the premises or the taking of sale or supply of alcohol to any person residing in the licensed premises;
- c. the ordering of alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- d. the sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- e. the sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of

State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces;

- f. the taking of alcohol from the premises by a person residing there; or the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to any private friends of a person residing there who are bona fide entertained by him at his own expense, or the consumption of alcohol by persons so supplied; or
- g. the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises to persons employed there for the purposes of the business carried on by the holder of the licence, or the consumption of liquor so supplied, if the liquor is supplied at the expense of their employer or of the person carrying on or in charge of the business on the premises.
- h. off sales of alcohol for consumption beyond the premise boundary must be sold in a sealed container and must not be consumed within the premise boundary.

#### LATE NIGHT REFRESHMENT

Supply of late night refreshment is restricted to consumption on the premise (i.e. no takeaway sales after 2300hrs)

#### LIVE MUSIC

A maximum of two performers during any opening period

#### **Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

Provision of Karaoke and live music is subject to use of a sound limiting device being installed on the premises and set in consultation with Environmental Health. A log of noise levels outside the premise is to be maintained and kept on the premises for the review on request of the Licensing Authority.

Except for access, egress and emergencies all windows and doors are to be maintained closed during regulated entertainment.

Outside drinking areas shall not be used after 23:00. Before this time the management will assess noise from these areas and if it is likely to cause unreasonable annoyance to neighbouring properties will take action to reduce noise levels to an acceptable level, including the option of garden closure.

Staff are to be provided at exit doors on Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings to ensure the quiet and orderly exit of patrons from the premises. On other nights at the end of the evening a member of staff will stand at the main exit door to ensure customers exit in a quiet and orderly manner.

Signage is to be placed prominently at exit points requesting patrons to leave the premises quietly.
