**(i) Nana Ofori-Atta Oguntola to Councillor Darlington (02/03/21 – 14.53)**

“I note with interest the recent prosecution by the Council regarding fly-tipping. Can you confirm how much of the fly-tipping has been by rogue traders or as a result of local tax payers not being able to book a slot at the recycle centres?”

**(ii) Andrew Carr to Councillor Darlington (02/03/21 – 16.21)**

“Now the consultation period is over could the cabinet member for highways outline the proposals for Tickford Street Traffic calming and what the timetable is for progressing the works please?”

**(iii) Shazna Muzammil to Councillor Darlington (03/03/21 – 21.23)**

“How many incidents of fly tipping have been reported in the Bletchley area over the last 3 months?”

**(iv) Edward Hume to Councillor Marland (03/03/21 – 22.20)**

“Please could you provide an update on the refused Bletchley Landfill planning application for a 15 year extension?”

**(v) Steve Murray to Councillor J Wilson-Marklew (04/03/21 – 09.59)**

“What is the council's plan to improve cycle safety on rural roads in the borough, in particular the road from Gayhurst to Newport Pagnell, where much of it is a national speed limit with no footpath. It is completely unsafe for family cycling.”

**(vi) Scot Balazs to Councillor Marland (04/03/21 – 16.44)**

“There was supposed to be an appeal hearing heard by the planning inspector in relation to Blakelands last month but the council firstly didn't send a notification letter out to interested parties or residents. As a result it had to be cancelled by PINs. A new date was set but THREE letters had to be sent notifying residents and interested parties because the department kept making mistakes. How can the leader continue to defend the planning department when so many mistakes, even very simple ones, have been made in relation to a single planning application?”

**(vii) Chris Taylor to Councillor Darlington (04/03/21 – 17.08)**

“What measures are MK Council undertaking to ensure consistently missed refuse collections do not continue to happen?”

**(viii) Ethan Wilkinson to Councillor Darlington (05/03/21 – 17.47)**

“Please could you provide an update on the ANPR cars? They were first promised in 2019 and two years later we are still waiting for the stronger parking enforcement measures in Loughton that we've been campaigning for”

**(ix) Town Councillor Mo Imran to Councillor Darlington (08/03/21 – 14.23)**

“I would like to ask about fly-tipping which has increased enormously in Bletchley. In my opinion the appointment system for the tips should be scrapped as most residents are telling me they have great difficulty in getting appointments when it suits them. Now that we are coming out of lockdown can the Council look at scrapping the booking system and providing easier access to the tips?”

**(x) Adam Rolfe to Councillor Darlington (08/03/21 – 16.47)**

“Roads in my area are crumbling. Which is why I and Bletchley residents were disappointed you voted against quadrupling the local pothole fund in the budget meeting last month.

There are potholes in the Bletchley West ward that have been reported, but never fixed. When do you plan on fixing the pothole problem?”
