Other information about this period

- Face-to-face review of the independent visitors’ contract between NYAS and managers from Milton Keynes took place on the 14 July 2016.
- Due to a number of circumstances the independent visitors for all three homes have been different from one month to the next. Although some consistency has been achieved by using the same visitor each month, this has not been ideal.

Action for September onwards

- NYAS to improve consistency with visitors to all three homes. Essentially, securing one visitor to commit to all three homes for a period of up to six-months.
