Agreed Conditions in respect of representations from

Trading Standards; Leon Residents Association

1. the supply of alcohol will be no later than 01:30hrs on Friday and Saturday,
2. that the premises shall close by 02:00 on those nights,
3. that all members and guests (so patrons, rather than staff) will be clear of the premises by the closing time specified on any night
4. An effective 'Challenge 25' policy shall be implemented and maintained in place at the premises. Any persons appearing to be under the age of 25 who attempts to enter the venue or purchase alcohol must be challenged in respect of their age and will be required to provide adequate proof that they are aged 18 years or over.
5. Only photographic based forms of identification shall be accepted as proof of age. These must be accredited to the PASS scheme or subsequent equivalent but could also include passport, HM forces ID card, driving licence, national ID card
6. A refusal log to record all attempts to enter the premises or purchase alcohol that were refused shall be recorded and kept on site. The log shall be checked and counter signed by the Designated Premises Supervisor on a regular basis and shall be provided to the Police, the Local Authority or the Licensing Authority on request.
