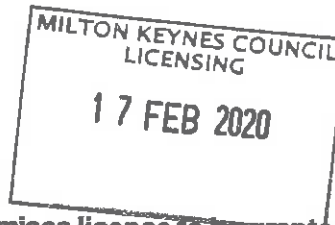

**a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)**

The premises will continue to maintain a club premises certificate. The premises licence will enable us to provide a limited number of events open to the public including our foodie Friday events and other fundraisers.

The areas to be licensed will be the events room, patio area to rear of the building, shed for off sales and the rugby pitch, upon which a marquee will be erected up to twice a year.

The events room will allow us to hold family parties and funerals without need to apply for TENs. The club does not envision more events to be held than currently experienced.

**b) The prevention of crime and disorder**

The premises will maintain a CCTV system for the internal areas that will store images for up to 28 days.

A generic risk assessment for determining the use of doorstaff will be produced. This will be tailored for specific events where larger numbers of the public are expected to attend.

A folder detailing the following will be kept on the premises:

- (a) all crimes reported to the venue
- (b) all ejections of patrons
- (c) any complaints received concerning crime and disorder.
- (d) any incidents of disorder
- (e) any faults in the CCTV system
- (f) any refusal of the sale of alcohol
- (g) any visit by a relevant or emergency service

**c) Public safety**

Generic risk assessments for events will be maintained, again tailored to specific events.

No glassware will be permitted for use outside the premises, other than wine glasses in the marquee during marquee events. All sales of alcohol from the wooden shed will be decanted into plastic vessels or be from plastic bottles.

**d) The prevention of public nuisance**

There will be no external provision of regulated entertainment in the outside area after 11pm other than in the marquee, which is limited to two occasions a year.

When music is provided in the events room, noise checks will be undertaken to ensure the music will not cause unreasonable disruption to local residents.

**e) The protection of children from harm**

A Challenge 25 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving Licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS Hologram. All staff will be trained to this effect.

A separate refusal log will be maintained for each of the bars when in operation.

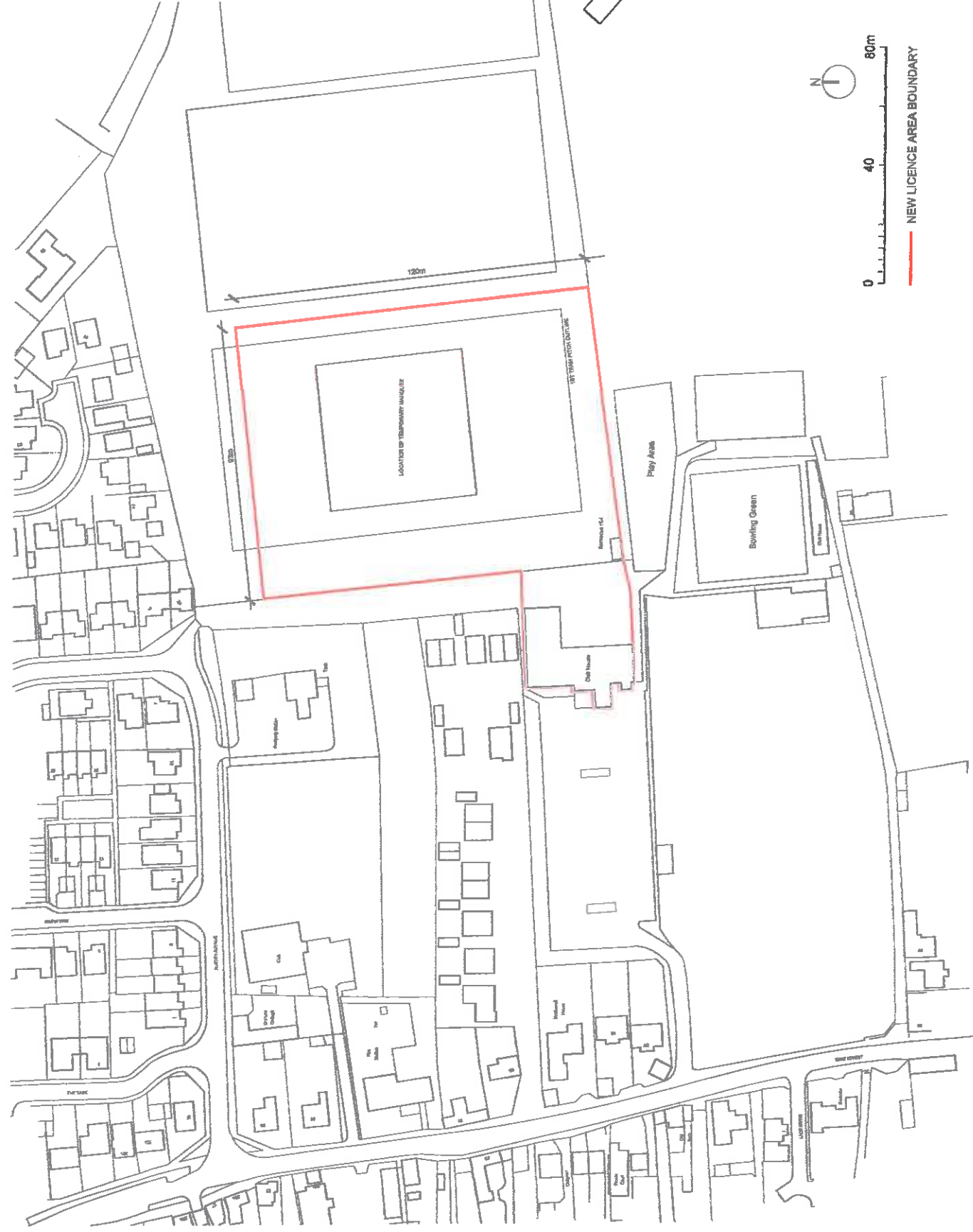

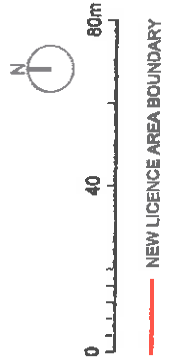

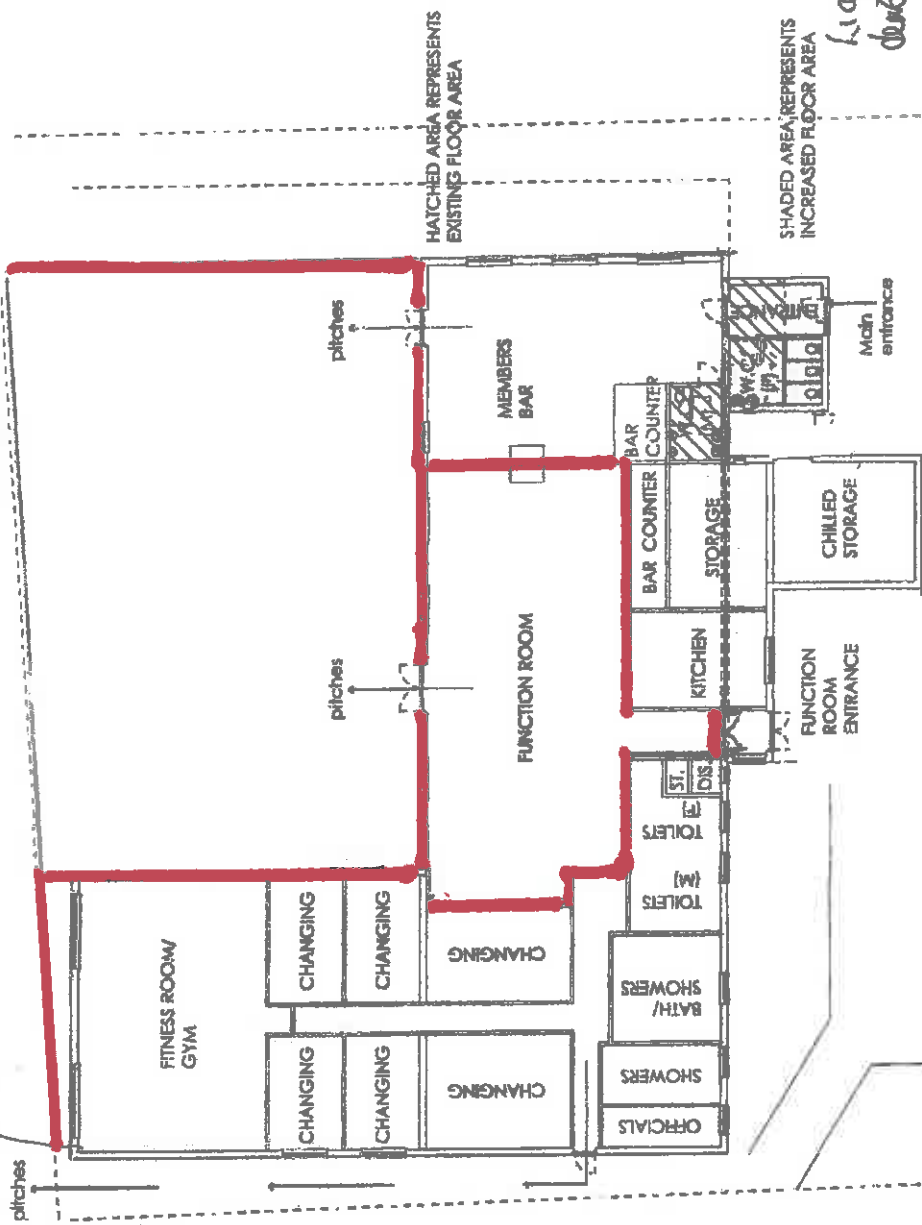
