I am writing to object to the application for a license for Shenley Kebabs. Conditions were placed on the licence at the last hearing of maintaining litter, keeping the area clean and tidy etc. I am disappointed to learn from Madison, the business that is located in Roebuck Way, that they've seen litter, oil bottles and evidence of urination in bushes. All of which appear to come from the kebab van. I've been to the site to look at the kebab van and was shocked to see two unroadworthy vehicles parked on the highway either side of the kebab van. I have checked with Environmental Crime at Milton Keynes Council that the vehicles are owned by Mr Dogan, and they have been there for some considerable time. I do not believe that Mr Dogan fulfilled the conditions of his licence previously, and I do not believe that he will do so again. For this reason I will be objecting to his application for a new licence.
