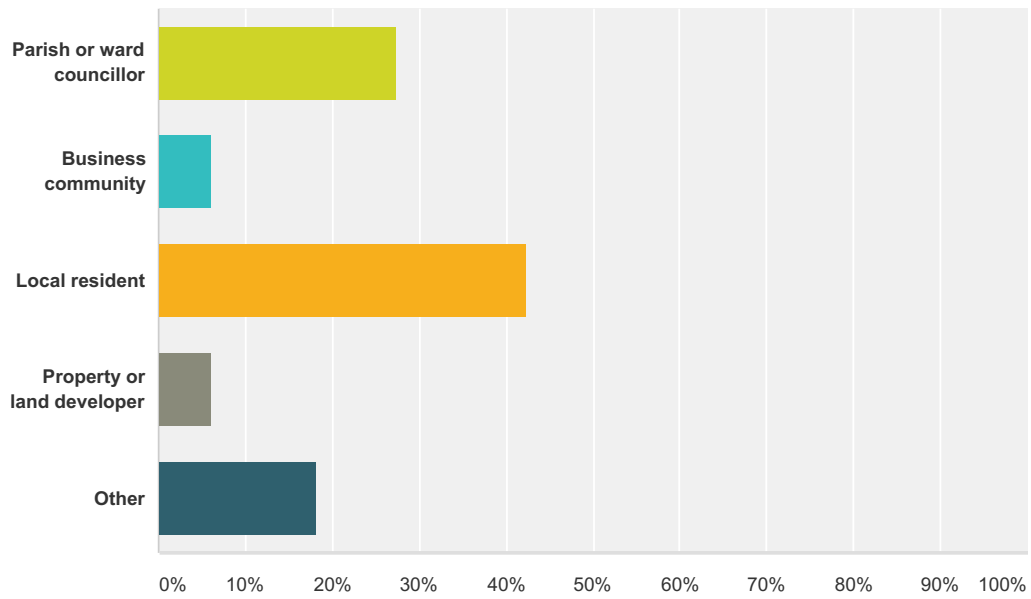


Q1 Which group do you belong to?

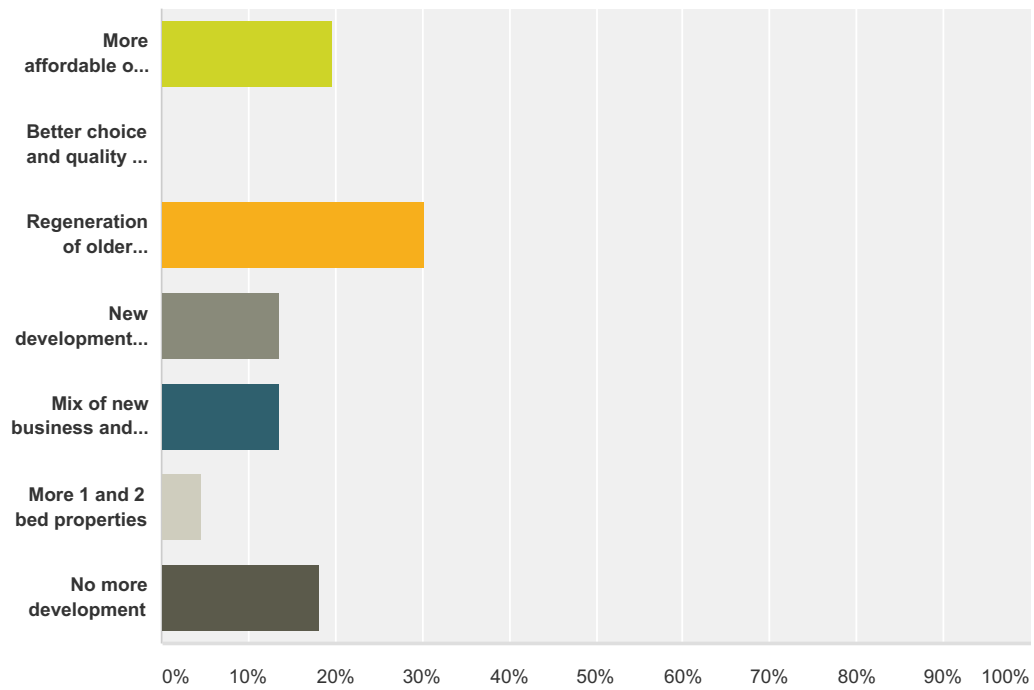

Q2 What type of development is most important to you?

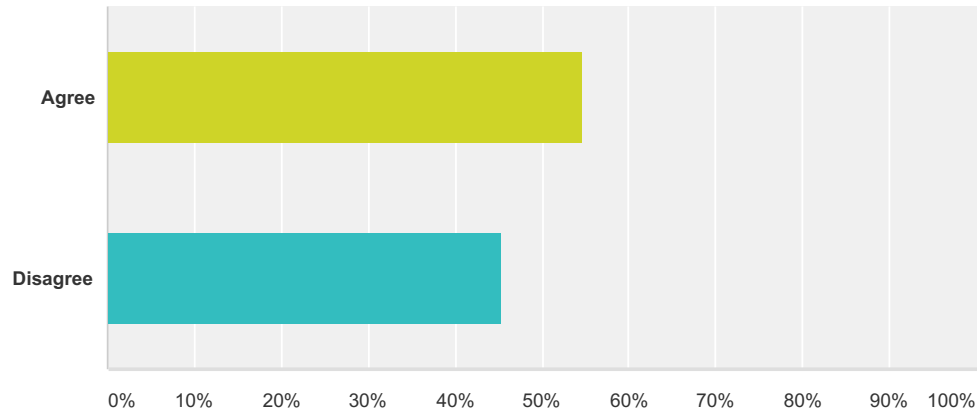

Q3 Councillors should make planning decisions if it is a big scheme with significant impact on MK. The smaller schemes can be left to Planning Officers.

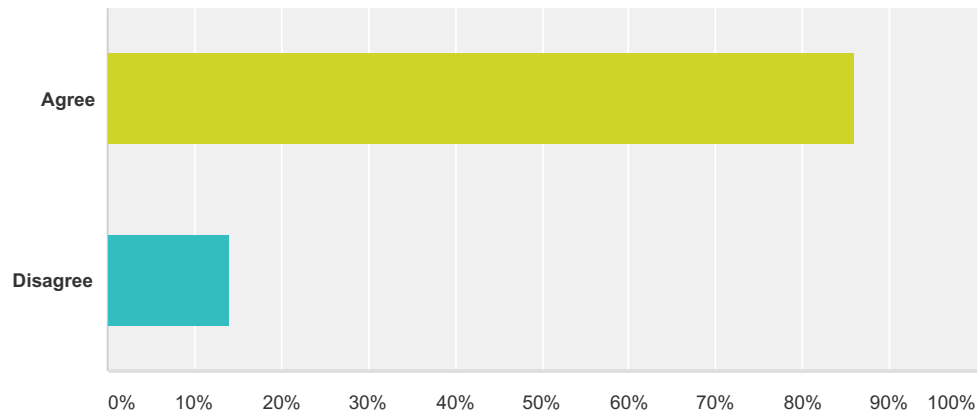

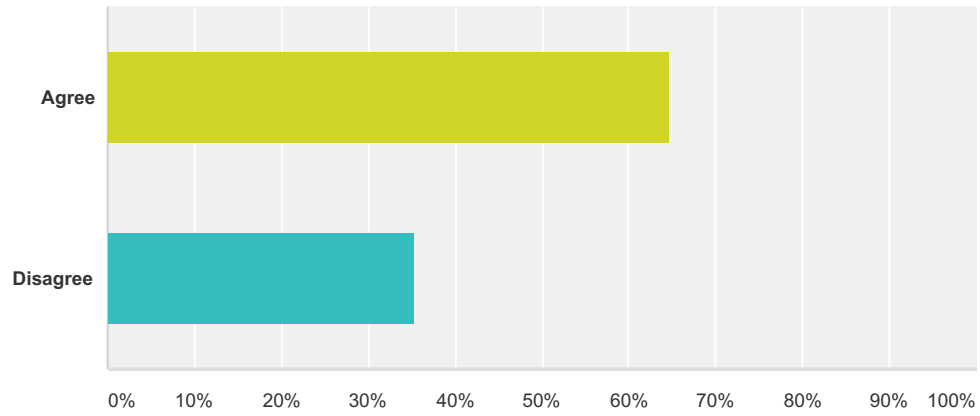

Q5 Speakers for and against a proposal should not make duplicate statements during a debate so the time is used more effectively

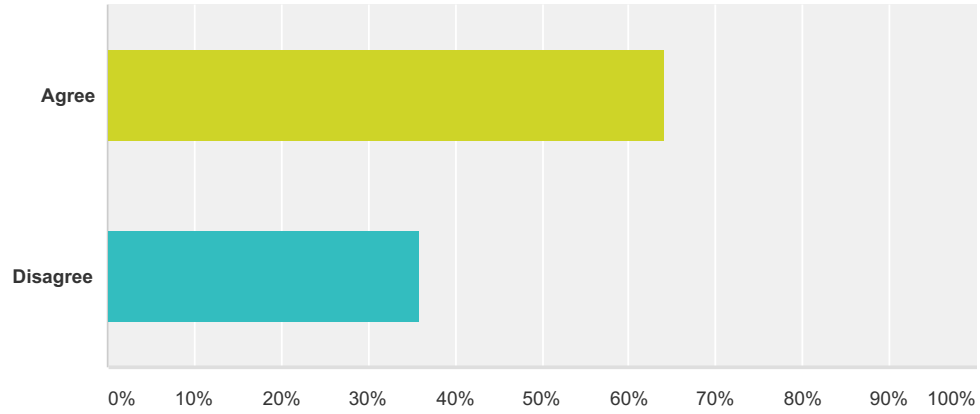

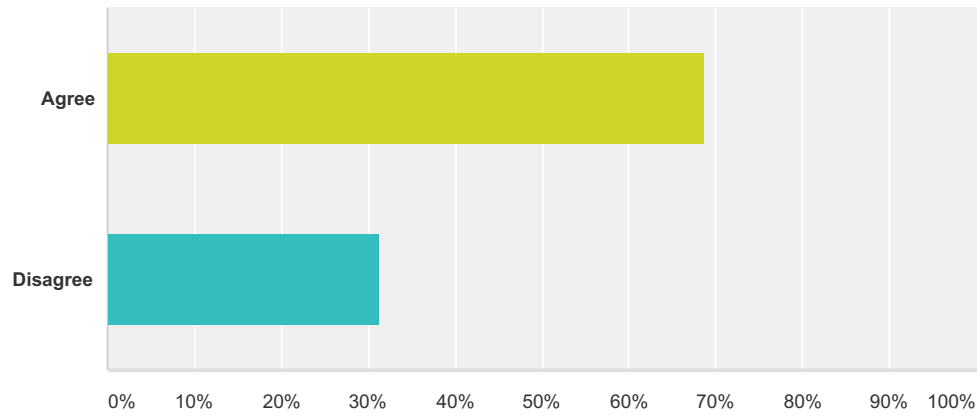

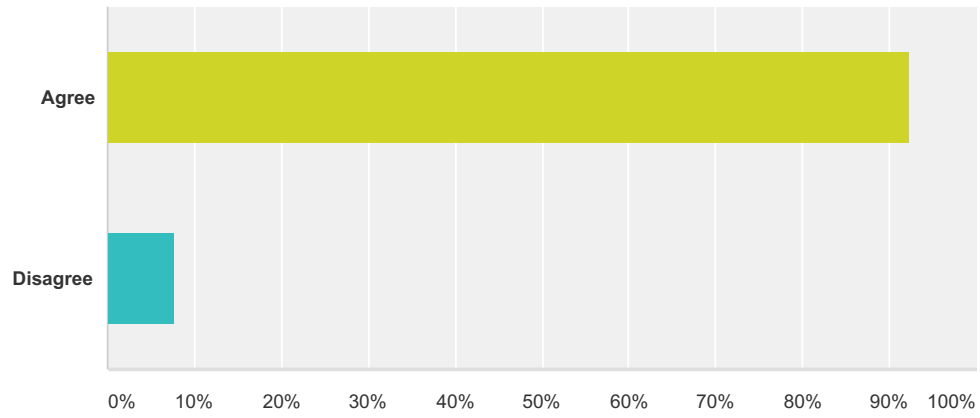

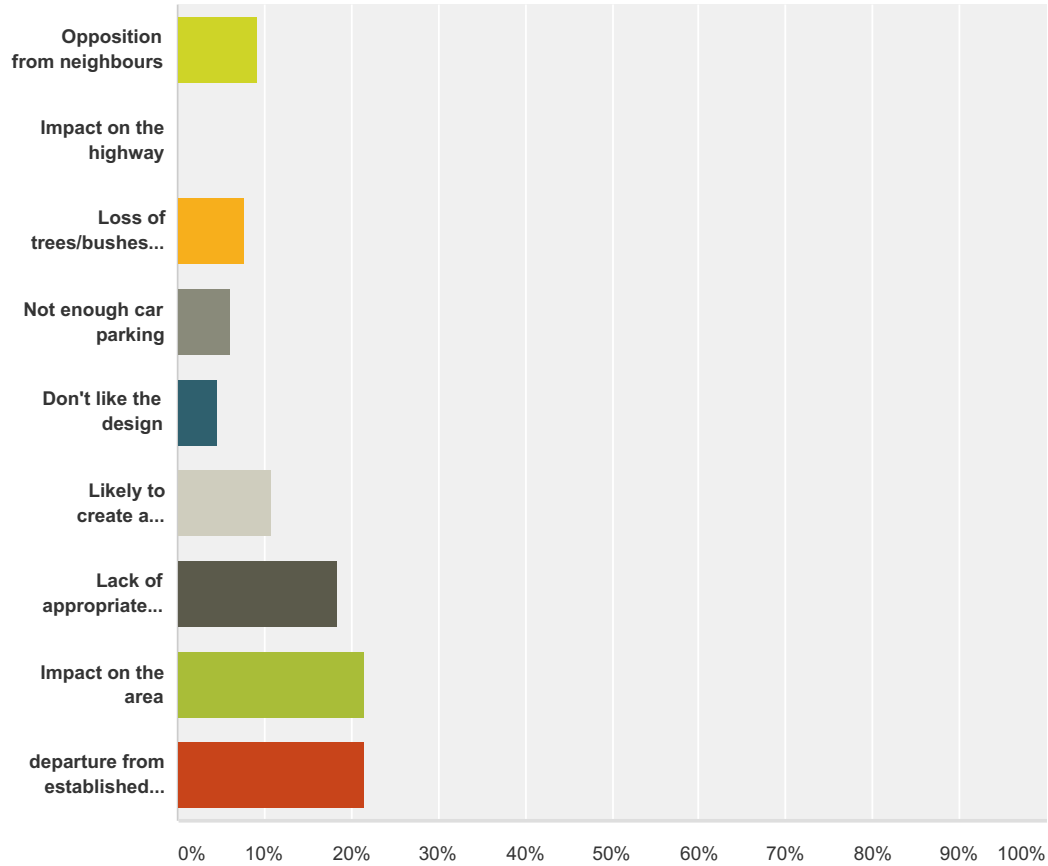
