

ALIGNMENT OF KEY STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

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Purpose of Report:

To present a final iteration of revised partnership arrangements for community safety, safeguarding and health and wellbeing.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 Proposals for closer alignment of key strategic partnerships have been informed by extensive consultation with partners. They are now presented for approval by Safer MK.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 The Safer MK partnership is asked to agree the proposed partnership arrangements for carrying out the business of the Community Safety Partnership.

3. Background

- 3.1 The partnership proposals which incorporate multi-agency safeguarding arrangements were approved by the Milton Keynes Safeguarding Board on 10 June 2019 and the Health and Wellbeing Board on 26 June 2010. The arrangements have been published in line with the requirements of Working Together 2018. The Department for Education indicated that there was no flexibility in terms of the publication deadline of 29 June 2019.
- 3.2 Views on the amended proposals have been sought from the Health and Wellbeing Board and Safer MK virtually in order to allow for the publication deadline to be met. No additional comments are received.
- 3.3 New arrangements must be implemented by the end of September. An implementation plan is in place with a view to moving to the new partnership structure in September.
