#### DRAFT CRIME REDUCTION TARGETS

##### 1. Purpose

- 1.1 To inform the Partnership of the complete draft crime and disorder reduction strategy for Milton Keynes.
- 1.2 To invite comment on any aspect of the strategy.

##### 2. Background

2.1 The attached strategy document (**Annex A**) serves two purposes:

- (a) the aims, objectives and targets represent the major issues that the Partnership will address during the next two years. These should be communicated to the public in a way that can be readily understood. The aims, objectives and targets should not change once the strategy has been finalised. This part of the strategy is also attached as a separate document (**Annex B**); and
- (b) the actions, end dates and lead officers represent the means by which the strategy will be carried into operation. They are designed as working tools for the delivery groups and sub-groups, and as such are likely to be amended or added to constantly during their working life. They are likely to be of less interest to the public.

2.2 It is proposed that the strategy will be finalised during the next month. A “mini-audit” of crime and disorder in Milton Keynes will be carried out for the period of April 1999 - March 2000 to provide baseline data for the strategy. The aims, objectives and targets may then be incorporated into a document which will be available to the public.

##### 3. Recommendations

- 3.1 That members consider the strategy document, and return any comments to the co-ordinators by Friday 17 March 2000.

- 3.2 That a baseline audit of crime and disorder be carried out in April 2000, details of which will be circulated before the next Partnership meeting.
- 3.3 That the aims, objectives and targets be incorporated into a public document during the next three months.
