In particular:

- There is no evidence of staff training: It is expected that all applicants will be able to demonstrate that their staff receive regular & adequate training on the law relating to age restricted sales.
- There is no evidence of the applicants intention to support PASS and other official photo identification schemes.
- There is no evidence of the applicants intention to maintain a refusal log.
