It was noted that the application in respect of Bletchley Night Club, 2 Watling Street, Bletchley, had been withdrawn to allow the full notification procedure to be followed. It was also reported that the application in respect of The Church of the Holy Cross, The High Street, Two Mile Ash, Milton Keynes, had been granted by officers under delegated powers as the electrical certificate had now been presented.

2. That the renewal of the Public Indoor Entertainments Licence for the Madcap Theatre, Creed Street, Wolverton from 9.00 am to midnight Sunday to Thursday and 9.00 am to 1.00 am the following day Friday and Saturday be granted.

 - (c) close liaison with the local representatives of Thames Valley Police over parking arrangements; and
 - (d) information on the parking arrangements to be printed on the tickets for the event.
2. That an Outdoor Entertainment Licence for 8 July 2000, between noon and 11.00 pm at the City Discovery Centre, Bradwell Abbey, Milton Keynes be granted.
