Revision of Partnership Strategy 2015/17

1.1 Brief introduction

- 1.2 The SaferMK has a statutory duty to develop and lead on a three year Strategy in order to fulfil its responsibility for reducing crime and the fear of crime.
- 1.3 A workshop was held with the Responsible Authority Leads in Milton Keynes in February 2015. The workshop revised the priorities based around current organisational issues, and data collated within the Strategic Assessment 2014.

- 1.4 The 4 main objectives for 2015-17 are:
- Improving road safety by reducing the number of accidents and the severity of the collisions to individuals.
 - Reducing the number of violent incidences
 - Tackling and enforcing substance misuse
 - Enhance community engagement to reduce the fear of crime
- 1.5 The Strategy also outlines the statutory obligations of the Partnership including Anti-Social Behaviour and Reducing Reoffending whilst also outlining other supporting activities to Partnership delivery.
- 1.6 The Strategy has been designed to maintain flexibility and responsiveness to emerging issues and to additionally allow the Partnership to be pro-active in meeting the needs of Milton Keynes.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 To comment and agree on the objectives and supporting mechanisms of the strategy and review updates.
- 2.2 To agree to include Reduction of Domestic and Sexual Abuse and Prevention of Organised Crime to the Plan.

3. Comments/Recommendations from the Overview and Scrutiny Management Group

- 3.1 There are no specific comments in relation this report. However it is a statutory obligation for the Committee to hold the activities and performance of the Partnership to account and ensure it meets its statutory duties.

4. Background

- 4.1 The Crime and Disorder Act 1998 makes it a statutory responsibility for the SaferMK Partnership to implement a three year strategy and supporting plan on delivering the priorities.
- 4.2 The SaferMK strategy 2015-17 is based on the strategic assessment 2014 and relevant documents and reports since March 2015. It is also based on the emerging central government policies, the Police and Crime Commissioner Plan and discussions with partners.

5. Implications to SaferMK Partnership

- 5.1 If a three year plan is not fulfilled the SaferMK Partnership would not be meeting one of its statutory requirements.

6. Other considerations / Key Partnership Involvement

- 6.1 With a range of agencies working in Milton Keynes towards reducing crime other community safety issues, it is important that the strategy is informed by the input of partners.
- 6.2 The strategy and its delivery will aim to highlight the work of other partners and partnerships.
- 6.3 The Police and Crime Commissioner Anthony Stansfeld has launched a survey seeking feedback from residents of the Thames Valley on policing and crime. The results of the survey will help inform the next Police and Crime Plan which is due to be published before the end of March 2017.
