

MILTON KEYNES CRIME AND DISORDER STRATEGY 2000-2003

The tables below outline the strategic aims, objectives and targets that have been developed for the Milton Keynes Crime and Disorder Strategy. Although all targets are important those highlighted in capitals are the head line targets, e.g. those that the Partnership will treat as a priority.
