**Subject: Late Night Levy Information paper**

**Reason for report**

To provide the RAG with information on the Late Night Levy, including process, current status and the Proposed Levy determined by the Licensing Committee.

**Background**

The Thames Valley Police have requested that Milton Keynes Council considers the introduction of a Late Night Levy (LNL) between the hours of 1am to 6am.

A LNL allows the Local Authority to charge a prescribed fee to any late night alcohol supply venue to help offset the cost of policing the night-time economy.

On 6 March 2013 the Licensing Committee agreed to hold a consultation as per the guidance for an LNL.
