Thames Valley Police are objecting to the above temporary event notice on the grounds that they do not feel the premises user is complying with the licensing objective of prevention of crime and disorder. Following the premises licence (which was previously in place at the premises, for which the user Sasa Lama was the DPS) having been revoked for non-compliance of conditions, Thames Valley Police were aware that the licence and licensing legislation was not always complied with during the appeal period. Following withdrawal of the appeal we have not objected to subsequent temporary event notices based on them being strictly adhered to. When the user did not comply with the notification procedure for a temporary event notice for the 6th – 8th January 2017, Milton Keynes Council rejected the notification and informed her by e-mail and telephone message of the rejection. I have since received confirmation from the premises and viewed CCTV footage to show that the event went ahead, and alcohol was sold for consumption on the premises as well as regulated entertainment provided, in breach of the Licensing Act 2005 Section 136.
