Appeal Against Decision not to Provide Home to School Transport

**TA5/00 APPEAL AGAINST DECISION NOT TO PROVIDE HOME TO SCHOOL TRANSPORT**

The Sub-Committee considered an appeal by Mrs A against the Local Education Authority's decision not to provide home to school transport.

The Panel heard the case of the appellant and the Local Education Authority and considered the statements submitted by both parties.

The panel noted that Mrs A's request was for transport to be provided for her children to travel from school to home at the end of the school day and that her husband would continue to take the boys to school at the beginning of the day.

RESOLVED -

1. That free transport be provided because of the unique family circumstances.

2. That the Local Education Authority be requested to review regularly (at least once each half term) any changes to family circumstances which means that the special circumstances no longer apply.
