On 07/03/2017, we received a Premise Licence application relating to Memlings Metro Ltd, Agora Centre, Church Street, Wolverton

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New premises licence, Recorded music & Sale of alcohol (on), Opening hours Sun-Thu 1000-0000 Fri-Sat 1000-0145, Late night refreshment Sun-Thu 2300-0000, Fri-Sat 2300-0145, (Also BH Mon until 0145 & Xmas Eve & NYE until 0300, with sale of alcohol to 0245)  
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Based on the supplied information, the Thames Valley Police response is: \*\*\* OBJECTION \*\*\*

Details of the objection and our rationale are below.

Having given consideration to the application as submitted by Memlings Metro Limited, I have concerns regarding the application as proposed, and would propose the following:

CCTV

*An adequate CCTV system shall be installed, maintained and operated at the premises. The system shall include camera covering of the licensable areas and include the entrance/exit, All recordings*

*shall be stored for a minimum of 28 days with date and time stamping. Recordings shall be made available to view or remove for evidential purposes upon the reasonable request of the Police, Licensing Authority or Local Authority.*

#### Door Staff

*There shall be a minimum of 2 door supervisors on duty at the premises on every night from 23:00hrs until the premises closes, where the premises trades past midnight.*

*A register of all door supervisors working on any evening is to be maintained at the premises, this shall log the name, SIA licence number, date & times worked of any door supervisors working at the premises.*

I am led to understand the new premises licence intends to have the same management team as the previous premises licence holder of the last premises licence at this premises. To assist the applicant with complying with the opening hours, I would recommend that all licensable activities cease 30 minutes prior to closing time on any given night, as under the previous licence they struggled repeatedly to have the premises clear of patrons prior to their closing time.

In relation to the non-standard timings, I also would not support the extra hours on the Bank Holiday Monday, as they are in a residential area, however I wonder if they perhaps mean the Sunday preceding a Bank Holiday Monday as opposed to the Bank Holiday Monday itself, in which case I would request that all licensable activities end 30 minutes prior to closing. I would also recommend that on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve the premises should close no later than 02:30hrs with all licensable activities ceasing 30 minutes prior to this.

In relation to Sasa Lama being the designated premises supervisor, following the premises having three occasions of selling alcohol not in accordance with a premises licence, (twice after licensed hours and once with no premises licence or temporary event notice in place) in the last year, where she was either the designated premises supervisor for the premises licence or the notifier for temporary event notice which was rejected by Milton Keynes Council.
